Virtual Golf Competition - Gosnells EBs vs Vire Golf Club France



We have been challenged by James (left above) and Peter (middle, ex-EB) to a virtual golf competition. (the other guy in the photo, Alan, a Welshman, is also involved)

If there some interest in this challenge, then the format would go something like this :

- Over 18 holes (2 weeks for us) using stableford scoring
- A player each from EBs and Vire would be paired, possibly based on similar handicaps, and will play each other. It is not essential that every EB participates.
- During the weeks prior, brief personal and golfing bios and photos will be exchanged
- Hopefully the pair will “get to know each” other by email, FaceTime, Skype, Facebook etc.
- After the game players will communicate their stableford score to their opponent.
- Scores will be tallied for both Clubs to determine the overall winning Club
- At some mutually agreed time, using FaceTime or similar, we “meet” at a function to announce the winning team. Perhaps there could be a Trophy or some other form of recognition for the winning team. James has already made an offer to provide such an incentive.
- The two Clubs would have to agree on the format and engage in the “getting to know you” process. Coordinators would need to be appointed.

Whilst the distance from Perth to Vire is 14,504 km, digital communication makes connection easy, even considering a six hour time zone difference.

Would you participate ? Playing the game would involve no more that playing “normal” EB golf over two weeks. Except that you are trying to beat your French opponent. You could even play outside usual EB times.

One of the opponents would be Peter Jago, an ex-EB and well known to many of us. Many of the “French” players would actually be expatriate Englishmen living in France, but there would be some real Frenchmen as well.
